## The Truth Will Out !

Palestinians are using the weapon of transparency in our century of information war

"Imperialism is the epoch of finance capital and of monopolies, which introduce everywhere ... reaction and an extreme intensification of ... national oppression" -- Lenin (1916)

The modern era of imperialism, as the final stage of capitalism, began around 1900 (see back page) and ushered in a century of world wars and fascism as well as modern technologies such as nuclear weapons, computers and the internet. This century, like the last one, looks like it will also be a century of fascism, war, and murder on an industrial scale, but it also promises to be a century of liberation as humanity and the working class make use of modern technology to raise their consciousness, organize themselves, overthrow the



system of imperialism and create a world of peace, abundance and genuine community for everyone.

The **mass slaughter** in Gaza has killed **23,000** (mainly civilians) with another **7,000** missing and likely buried under rubble. Schools, hospitals, shops, residential buildings and refugee camps have been leveled with 2,000 pound bombs. Journalists are being especially targeted. 85% of Gaza's 2.3 million people are now displaced and homeless. Experts say deaths from disease will eventually exceed deaths from bombs due to a severe lack of clean drinking water, food, fuel and sanitation.

The days in which **imperialism** can commit these crimes **away from the eyes** of most of the world, however, are gone. The **carnage in Gaza** is being watched by **millions** on social media, in spite of *manipulative algorithms* and *censorship*. More than this, **millions are now able to see for themselves** *inspiring scenes* of **resistance**. For example, I went to the YouTube channel for *The Electronic Intifada* and saw videos of **heroic Palestinian fighters** emerge from tunnels and **destroy** Israeli tanks. This helps us *understand our future* in which a **universal** and **democratic** social media platform (that cannot be censored) will bring **light** and **consciousness** to the working class and oppressed and knowledge of their **historic mission** and **destiny**.

#### *Letter from a Reader:* Imperialism, Socialism and the language of our self-deceit

Jason replied to Leaflet # 4, which outlined Lenin's analysis of imperialism as the final stage of capitalism, and also explained the problem with words such as "socialism". (*Edited for concision and clarity*)

You did a good job, Ben, in summarizing Lenin's pamphlet "Imperialism, the Highest Stage of Capitalism", but you should have advertized the title, as it ought to be more widely read.

Many get bogged down in details, instead of grasping the essence of the matter: modern imperialism is the **inherent result of modern capitalism**, rather than a **relic of the past**, or a result of **bad thinking** or **malign will**. We must be explicit that **getting rid of imperialism** necessarily involves **getting rid of capitalism**, and vice versa. And we must be explicit that **imperialism is a form of competition between capitalist states**.

The working class can only bring an end to war and imperialism by **overthrowing capitalist rule** and building a **new economic system** based on **co-operation** and **sharing**. That is what we mean by "**socialism**".

#### **Ben replies**

You make a good point, Jason, that many **lose sight** of the **central idea** in Lenin's pamphlet, written in the middle of the first world war--that is **key** to understanding **modern war** and **modern politics**.


Lenin's point is **simple**: he shows through charts and statistics how **capital** grew and **concentrated** into **monopoly**--and a close network of dependent relationships--until it essentially **took over everything**. By 1900, in the major imperialist countries, capital **owned** the politicians, **owned** the mass media, and **owned** essentially all the modern **institutions** of society. And since the growth of the major powers is **uneven**, and capital is organized and regulated on a **national** basis--**war** becomes **inevitable** as the necessary **redivision** of the world can **only** take place on the basis of **strength**.

In this way, we can see that capital functions as a **non-human force**, like something out of **science fiction**. The humans in our ruling class are only in

the **loop** to the extent that they **obey** the **will** of **capital**. And capital only wants to **grow** (like a **cancer**). This simple idea cuts through the **mountains of bullshit** we are **fed** every day.



The major decisions of **war** and **peace** --and everything else--are based on **the need for capital to expand**.



In contrast to the **clarity** and **power** of this idea, we can note the **reformist illusions** promoted not only by our media and schools--but from within the **Palestinian Solidarity Movement** itself by groups like the *Democratic Socialists of America* (**DSA**) -which urges activists to join their **noble crusade** to "**oust the pro-corporate, pro-war politicians**" and "**dismantle the US war machine**". How will the DSA accomplish these **miracles**? By **channeling** activist **energy** into the **black hole** of *bankrupt electoral politics* and promoting the **influence** and **ideology** of the **imperialist Democratic Party**.

As far as defining "socialism", there is a problem with your proposal: it is impossible to have clear ideas without clear language--without words that are real. The word "socialism" -- as it is used today by the people with the big megaphones -and actually understood by most people -- refers to an imaginary kinder, gentler (and less imperialistic) form of capitalism. So you or I might use this word to mean one thing--but objectively-what people would hear from us--would be something else entirely. We might think we are telling people to overthrow capitalist rule--but we would end up telling them to make it less bad.
