Algeria and Palestine

The victory of the national liberation war in Algeria points to the liberation of Palestine

Over the past 4 months in Gaza, Israel has deliberately slaughtered tens of thousands of civilians with the help of U.S. weapons and money. Extreme shortages of food and water, together with a lack of sanitation and shelter has put hundreds of thousands at risk. With the help of the lies and complicity of the mass media, Israel is orchestrating mass starvation.

The Nazis in 1942 systematically starved the 500,000 men, women and children in the Warsaw Ghetto. Israel intends to exceed this number.

Since Israel was created in 1948 as a colonial fortress of the US and Europe in the strategic and oil-rich Middle East, Israel has engaged in more than a ►

► dozen wars and an unending series of massacres and brutality against the native Palestinians, who were driven from their lands and herded into squalid ghettos. But, in spite of the lies of our mass media and the manipulation and "shadow banning" of social media, the truth is emerging, and the worldwide ► ► protests of millions are making clear that Israel, as a Jewish supremacist state based on Apartheid, will be replaced with a democratic state with equal rights for all.

The path forward for the Palestinian solidarity movement must be based on the lessons of successful struggle against **Apartheid** in **South Africa**, as well as the **national liberation struggles** of **Ireland** against Britain, **Algeria** against France, and **Vietnam** against France and then the U.S.

In all of these struggles, a key role was played by the war for **public opinion** in the oppressing country. In the case of Palestine, it is U.S. imperialism and its European allies which are the oppressing countries—as Israel is essentially a **U.S. colony**. Hence, what activists do here counts—a lot.


From a recent public facebook thread:

It shouldn't be possible that while an entire people are being straight up demolished, that the world can just go on like nothing's happening.

Excerpts from 75 comments in reply:

I feel like this everyday too. I eavesdrop into people's conversation when I'm out and I hear no one ever talking about it. . . . It sucks to feel this helpless I feel the exact same way. I've felt disappointment, frustration, etc., in everyone in my circle and on social media. They aren't necessarily pro Israel, but *just oblivious.* ■ *Right!? When I post on my* wall/story, I get very few responses. They are usually from friends not in the US. At best, I think Facebook gives them low visibility. I feel the same way. You are not alone. It's like living in a split-reality. So *disorienting and sad.* I keep asking myself the same question. How do we keep going on like everything is *fine?* • *We definitely need new people.* • *I feel this* and don't have any answers. It all makes me beyond sad. ■ ditto ■ I agree ■ What's wrong with people! What is happening is worse than a horror show. No *outrage?* • *Our society is extremely atomized and*



people don't know their own power. We have a lot of work to do to rebuild a fighting anti-war movement.
I blame the indifference on corporate news, where nothing is explained in depth, the interests of the ruling class determine how everything is phrased, and progressive opinions are dismissed.
I feel the same way, I'm heartbroken
Yes that's how I feel too !!!!!

Since the capitalist media will never tell people the truth--we need to do it ourselves! We need a city-wide campaign to flood schools and workplaces with leaflets as well as to help organize for large and powerful mass actions.
